Demonstrations and hands-on activities in a re-created logging settlement typical of 1790, make for a fun and educational field trip. Demonstrators in period clothing will be making sparks fly in the blacksmith shop, showing furs in the trapper's cabin, cooking in the family cabin and weaving in the sawyer's house.

Wagon rides tour the grounds, crossing the covered bridge after passing the water-powered saw mill. The ride goes by the field where games and crafts make the day "hands-on". Bring a picnic lunch-lemonade for \$.25! The gift shop will be open as well.

Chaperones will be responsible for supervising groups at all times and assisting as students move from activity to activity. (Recommended: 1 adult per 6-8 children)

Directions: The Maine Forest and Logging Museum is located off Rte. 178 in Bradley, between Milford and Brewer. From Brewer take Rte. 9 East, turn left onto Rte. 178.
