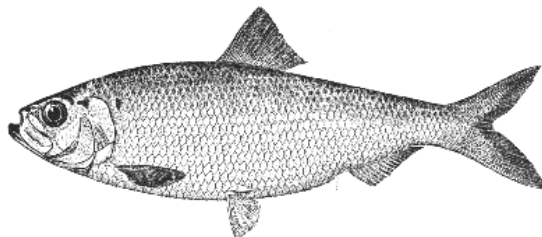




## 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Blackman Stream Alewife Cross Country Run
