

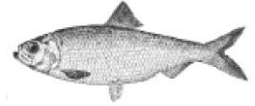

## Children's Days 2022

Demonstrations and hands-on activities in a re-created logging settlement typical of 1790 make for a fun and educational field trip. Demonstrators in period clothing will be making sparks fly in the Blacksmith Shop, showing furs in the Trapper's Cabin, and weaving in the Sawyer's House.

Horse-drawn wagon rides tour the grounds, crossing the covered bridge after passing the Water-powered Sawmill. The ride goes by the field where the games and crafts make the day "hands-on". The alewives should be running--kids may get wet moving alewives into the fish ladder! Bring a picnic lunch-lemonade for 50¢. The gift shop will be open as well--it helps the museum! Many inexpensive items!

Chaperones will be responsible for supervising all groups, regardless of age, and assisting as students move from activity to activity. (Recommended: 1 adult per 6-8 children.)

Reservations for Children's Days are limited and will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Confirmations will be sent via email along with additional information. No rain dates, so dress appropriately and be prepared for black flies.
